

COVID-19 VACCINE BOOSTER INFO



WHO

- 65 or older;
- 18 or older with an underlying medical condition or living in a long-term care setting;
- 18 or older working in a high-risk setting

WHEN

- At least 6 months after initial series

DOSE

- One shot with the same dosage as the original series (30 micrograms)

MIX & MATCH

- Yes, at least 6 months after receiving initial series

STORAGE REQUIREMENTS

- **Ultra-cold Freezer:** between -90 degrees Celsius and -60 degrees Celsius until expiration date
- **Freezer:** between -25 degrees Celsius and -15 degrees Celsius for up to 2 weeks
- **Refrigerator:** between 2 degrees Celsius and 8 degrees Celsius for up to 31 days. Contact manufacturer after 31 days

COMMON SIDE EFFECTS

- Pain at injection site, fatigue, muscle pain, headache, chills, swollen lymph nodes in the same arm as the injection site, fever, nausea and vomiting

WHO

- 65 or older;
- 18 or older with an underlying medical condition or living in a long-term care setting;
- 18 or older working in a high-risk setting

WHEN

- At least 6 months after initial series

DOSE

- One shot with half the dosage of the original series (50 micrograms)

MIX & MATCH

- Yes, at least 6 months after receiving initial series

STORAGE REQUIREMENTS

- **Freezer:** between -50 degrees Celsius and -15 degrees Celsius until expiration date
- **Refrigerator:** between 2 degrees Celsius and 8 degrees Celsius for up to 30 days. Contact the manufacturer after 30 days

COMMON SIDE EFFECTS

- Pain at injection site, fatigue, muscle pain, headache, fever, chills and nausea

WHO

- Anyone 18 and older that initially received a J&J shot

WHEN

- At least 2 months after initial shot

DOSE

- One shot with the same dosage as the original shot (0.5 mL)

MIX & MATCH

- Yes, at least 2 months after receiving initial shot

STORAGE REQUIREMENTS

- **Refrigerator:** between 2 degrees Celsius and 8 degrees Celsius until expiration date

COMMON SIDE EFFECTS

- Pain at injection site, fatigue, muscle pain, headache, fever, chills and nausea
