Where are the trainings held?	Mostly on the Providence campus, with some travel to south central hospitals	On the Providence campus in the OR education room.	Wherever you like – this is an online course.
How long is the training?	The in-person training didactic is two one-week sessions split by a month of clinical rotations at the home campus.	The Peri-op clinical academy is 4 weeks of on-site didactic training and clinical work followed by 11 weeks of clinical practicum in the home hospital.	The course must be completed within a year for reimbursement.
How do travel accommodations work?	Travel accommodations are coordinated through the home hospital and AHHA reimburses up to \$1,200 per week.	Travel accommodations are coordinated through the home hospital and AHHA reimburses up to \$1,200 per week with a maximum of \$4800.	Travel reimbursement is not applicable for Gero Prep.
What about costs for course materials?	AHHA can reimburse for course materials - cost of the Gnosis modules has not yet been determined.	AHHA can reimburse for course materials. Nurses are strongly encouraged to bring a laptop to the training but laptops are not a reimbursable expense.	AHHA reimburses up to \$600 for Gero Prep <i>completion</i> .
Is there a syllabus I can review?	Not at this time - the Peri-Natal training program is currently being revised.
