# Joint Accreditation: Interprofessional Continuing Education

- Currently awaiting decision from Joint Accreditation
  - Determination will be shared by end of December 2025
  - Accreditation would begin in January 2026
- Accreditation covers
  - Physicians
  - Nurses
  - Pharmacists
  - Physician Assistants
  - Psychologists
  - Social Workers
  - Optometrists
  - Dentists
  - Dietitians
- Accreditation will be offered on a fee for services basis
