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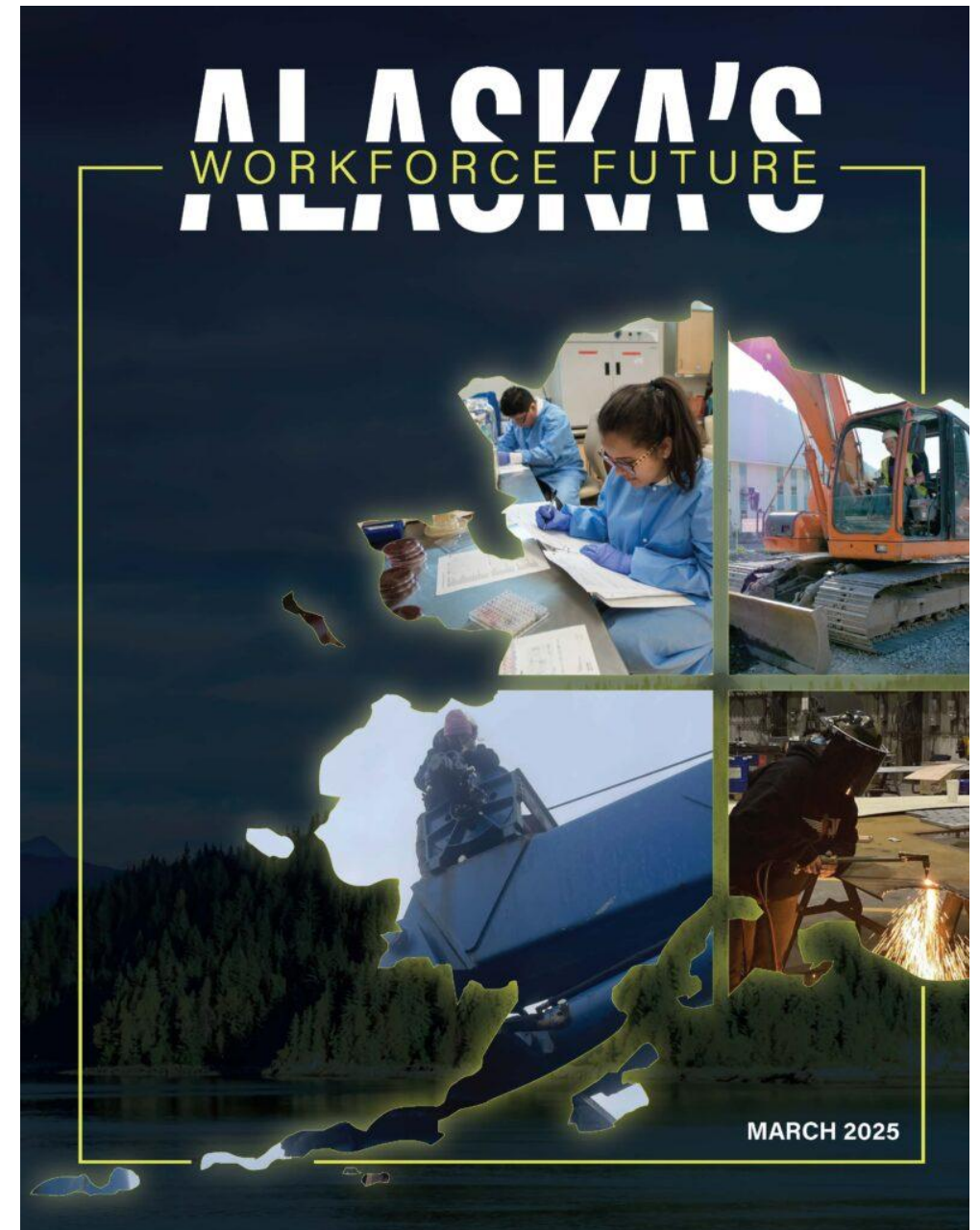
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6 Shared Goals

Align AHWC with Existing AWA Initiatives

- Build connective tissue and alignment across stakeholders to achieve workforce outcomes through convenings and regular communications
- Pilot and scale innovative workforce programs and practices to support Alaskan workers and employers
- Provide support and technical assistance to education and employer training entities
- Serve as a “one stop shop” for education and workforce data to support stakeholder decision making and investments
- Act as a private sector hub to include the voice of employers in our work
