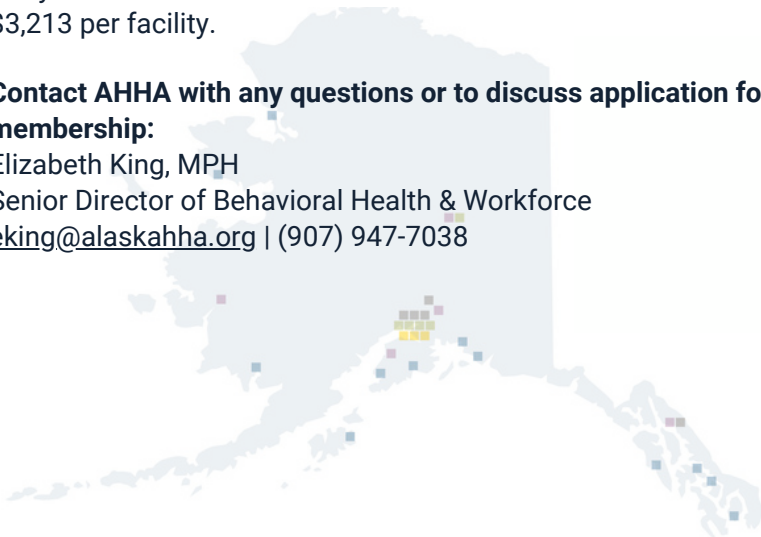

- Bi-monthly committee meetings focus on key topics and provide opportunities to connect with other hospitals and behavioral health organizations.
- Alaska legislature and media look to AHHA as industry experts. In 2022, AHHA secured the first rate increase to General Relief in 20 years. We supported the passage of HB 172 which opens the door for crisis-level care including 23-hour and short-term stabilization. Behavioral Health members have the opportunity to participate in setting AHHA's legislative advocacy priorities each year.
